

# 20 things to do without a car

- 1) **Visit The Minack theatre** - take Bus A3 to Lands End then onwards to MT.
- 2) **Walk the coastal path to Zennor** - Take bus A3 to Zennor then walk back
- 3) **Take the open top bus service to Lands End**—Take Bus A3
- 4) **Go Go-karting in St Erth** - see leaflet rack
- 5) **Visit St Michaels Mount** - take bus A2 to Marazion
- 6) **Walk to Lelant and take the scenic train journey back to St Ives** - catch the path from Porthminster beach and simply keep the water on your left hand side
- 7) **Take the bus to Trengwaiton gardens** - Take bus A17 from St Ives
- 8) **Go to the Penzance Lido** - Take any bus to Penzance station, then 10 min walk
- 9) **Walk the St Michaels Way** - follow in the footsteps of the pilgrims path. Walk along the coastal path east then follow the way marks
- 10) **Take a surf lesson with the St Ives Surf school** - see posters
- 11) **Visit Tate, St Ives**
- 12) **Read a book up on The Island** - Peaceful; great views; lots of benches
- 13) **Do some geo-caching around St Ives, Carbis Bay and Lelant.** - Check out the geo-caching app
- 14) **Go to the cinema** - our local cinema is a bit grimy, a bit tatty in areas but has loads of character—especially Screen 1
- 15) **Visit Geevor Tin mine** - Take bus A3
- 16) **Go on a Poldark pilgrimage and visit Bottalock mines** - Bus A3
- 17) **Get up early and see the sun rise over St Ives** - check sunrise times
- 18) **Walk along the 3 mile Hayle beach to Godrevy point to see the seal colony** - best time for walking the beach is low tide and mid-tide for seals
- 19) **Learn to kite-surf on Hayle beach** - there are various kite-surfing schools operating from here
- 20) **Take a game of golf in** - West Cornwall course for proper golfers or the pitch and putt for the playful ones
